will be accompanying you and bring a 30 second script so we can sing your

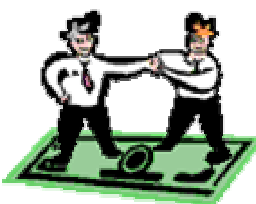
praises.

**Carol Stream Chamber RSVP Policy**

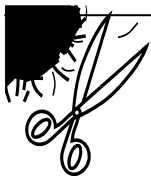
Over the years, the chamber has been very flexible with luncheons and RSVPs to events. Typically, we have many no-shows and many walk-ins at each monthly luncheon. One month twenty members who RSVP'd didn't show. This makes it very tough on the kitchen, who does it's best to provide for everyone, with some extras allowed. But planning for that on a regular basis can get expensive.

The Board has come to a decision and voted on a new policy and will

enforce an existing policy. Beginning at the June luncheon, the cost to make a reservation up until 5:00pm the night before will be \$20. Walk-ins will cost \$25. On the other hand, someone who has made a reservation and does not show will be invoiced for \$15.

New to the site in the past few months are two features – Hot Deals and Job Postings. If you'd like low cost advertising, run a special Hot Deal for \$5/week, minimum 4 weeks. Do you have an opening at your company? Is your son-in-law out of work? Looking for a job for Junior? Visit the Job Postings for employment needs.

Chamber members log in to ChamberMaster.com and use the login and password they were given. From there they are able to update their company information, hours of operation and submit job postings.

“Were You There” is a link to the last few years of some very special events, complete with recap and photos. Maybe you are in one of those photos?



Use the chamber website instead of your favorite yellow pages and find what you need as you connect to the chamber through your keyboard.
